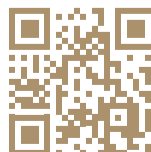

## AMERICAN VITICULTURAL AREA AVA

*An American Viticultural Area (AVA), is a designated grape-growing region in the United States, analogous to French appellations. It defines a specific wine-growing area based on its distinct geographic and climatic characteristics. These characteristics, such as proximity to lakes or mountain ranges, influence the character of the grapes and distinguish an AVA from its surrounding regions. Wineries can use the AVA designation on their wine labels to inform consumers about the origin of their wines. The year in parentheses indicates when the region was officially recognized as an AVA by the **Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms**.*

# WHITE WINE

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## NAPA VALLEY AVA (1981)

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### BEYOND CABERNET

Napa Valley, while renowned for its red wines, also boasts an impressive selection of white wines. The region's Mediterranean climate, tempered by cooler influences in specific areas, creates ideal conditions for Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay. Sauvignon Blanc showcases vibrant acidity and lively fruit flavors (citrus, tropical) with a touch of grassy character. Chardonnays vary depending on origin

and aging, ranging from lean and mineral to opulent with a creamy texture and buttery notes. In addition to these classics, winemakers are increasingly experimenting with Rhône Valley varieties like Viognier, Roussanne, and Marsanne, producing exotic, floral white wines with spicy nuances. Varieties like Albariño further enrich the spectrum with their zesty, saline style.

Chardonnays offer captivating citrus, white peach, and a touch of brioche, while Sauvignon Blancs brim with zesty citrus and invigorating gooseberry notes. Both shine with a signature fruit intensity, a delight for white wine enthusiasts.*

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**HOWELL MOUNTAIN AVA (1983)**

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**CHARACTERFUL WHITE WINES  
FROM THE HEIGHTS OF THE VACA MOUNTAINS**

*The Howell Mountain AVA, situated in the northeast of Napa Valley, is defined by a warm, dry climate and high-elevation vineyards (420–670 m ASL). Porous, volcanic soils serve to moderate the heat, creating ideal conditions for white varieties, particularly Sauvignon Blanc — wines distinguished by a pronounced character, minerality, and elegance. To preserve the finesse and freshness of these mountain-grown whites, producers often limit lush aging and the use of new oak. While Sauvignon Blanc is the star, Chardonnay and Viognier also excel in this unique terroir.*

*The Santa Maria Valley AVA opens westward to the Pacific Ocean, ranging from 60 to 980 meters ASL in elevation with sandy-clay soils, ideal for growing Chardonnay. Morning sea fog flows in unimpeded, creating a cool climate for slow grape ripening, while the slopes*

*receive more sunlight. Chardonnay is the main variety here, benefiting from the coolness to produce elegant, precise, long-lasting wines with citrus, floral, herbal, and mineral notes. Pinot Noir also thrives in this region, showing lifted, herbal, and savory character.*

*region's flagship variety, celebrated for producing wines with a distinctive mineral freshness, remarkable complexity, and impressive longevity. Sauvignon Blanc, Gewürztraminer, and Viognier also thrive in this unique terroir, contributing to the region's diverse range of white wines.*

*The expansive Sonoma Coast AVA stretches from San Pablo Bay to the Mendocino County border. Known for its cool climate influenced by Pacific fog and high rainfall, it offers ideal conditions for slow-ripening viticulture. Most vineyards lie above the fog line at elevations warm enough for grapes to*

*fully develop. The extended growing season and temperate conditions allow Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc to thrive, yielding wines characterized by freshness, finesse, complexity, and pronounced minerality, showcasing alluring aromatics of citrus, flowers, and a compelling mineral essence.*

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## ATLAS PEAK AVA (1992)

*Established in 1992, the Atlas Peak AVA towers high above Napa Valley with vineyards between 250 and 800 meters ASL in elevation. Warm days and cool fog banks favor a long ripening period for the grapes. Sauvignon Blanc is the leading variety, delighting with fresh acidity, ripe fruit aromas*

*(citrus, green apple, exotic fruits), and mineral notes – volcanic soils and the unique microclimate give the wines a concentrated, multi-layered character. Chardonnay and Viognier, also to be found in these high elevations, develop a lovely freshness and elegance.*
